Overtime Guidelines

For overtime payroll allocation WCF Insurance applies guidelines established by the Utah Insurance Department. Under the rule overtime pay is excluded from payroll calculations. Below is a summary of the guidelines.



OVERTIME

The overtime guidelines describe overtime as any hours worked for which there is an increase in the rate of pay. Examples of overtime pay may include:

- a. Work in any day, or in any week, in excess of the number of hours normally worked
- b. Hours worked in excess of eight hours in any day or 40 hours in any week
- c. Work on Saturday, Sunday, or holidays
- d. In the case of a guaranteed-wage agreement, overtime means only those hours worked in excess of the number specified in a set agreement.

Regular Hourly Wage	\$10.00
Overtime Hourly Wage	\$15.00
Overtime Rate Used for Premium Calculation	\$10.00

QUALIFICATION

To qualify for the exclusion of extra pay for overtime, the policyholder's books and records must document overtime pay separated by employee and classification.

To qualify for exclusion of overtime pay, policyholders must document overtime separated by employee and classification.
