Utah Businesses Receive Top Awards for Workplace Safety

WCF Honors Utah's Companies and Presents Safe Workplace Scholarships

SALT LAKE CITY, June 5, 2012—With thousands of Utahns reporting workplace injuries last year, Workers Compensation Fund is working to promote—and honor—workplace safety. Helping kick off June as National Safety Month, WCF will award 14 companies at its Traditions of Safety event held today at the Little America Hotel in Salt Lake City.

With an eye toward tomorrow's safety leaders, WCF will also award scholarships totaling \$16,500 to graduate students at the University of Utah's Rocky Mountain Center for Occupational and Environmental Health (RMCOEH). And in support of the center's occupational safety research and education efforts, donate \$150,000 to the Rocky Mountain Center.

From construction to trucking to manufacturing and municipal services, the winners of the 2012 WCF Charles A. Caine Workplace Safety Awards are a diverse group of Utah-based businesses with something in common: their commitment to safety. Many of the honorees practice similar safety management tactics, including written safety plans, regular safety training, accident analysis, employee involvement in the safety process, and incentive programs.

Recipients of the 2012 Dr. Paul S. Richards Safe Workplace Scholarships are graduate students at the Rocky Mountain Center studying occupational safety, industrial hygiene, occupational medicine and ergonomics. WCF began the scholarship program in 1997, and recently renamed the scholarships for Utah's twentieth century pioneer of occupational medicine and workplace safety, Dr. Paul S. Richards. Dr. Richards was instrumental in bringing about Utah's first Occupational Disease Disability Act in 1941. He also made a tremendous contribution to Utahns as he headed the Bingham Canyon hospital for more than 25 years.

"The importance of workplace safety cannot be underestimated—every effort Utah companies make to protect their workers helps protect individuals and families from injury, pain, financial hardship and more." said Ray Pickup, WCF president and CEO. "We applaud these award-winning companies who lead the way in workplace safety, and honor the students who will lead the future of workplace safety in years to come.
