WCF SAFETY & HEALTH MASTER

Must complete the Associate requirements and attend the following three required courses from the WCF safety seminar schedule.

REQUIRED COURSES

Advanced Ergonomics (1/2 day)
Best Practices in Safety: ANSI Z-10 Standard (1/2 day)
Occupational Health Hazards for the Safety Manager (1/2 day)
+9 hours or 6 1.5-hour Seminars



RECOGNITION FOR COMPLETING THE PROGRAM

Those completing the requirements for either level will receive a certificate and will be recognized for their accomplishment at the annual WCF Safety Awards luncheon, on the WCF website, and in other WCF publications.

REQUIREMENTS

- Each designation must be obtained within five years of applying for the program.
- Master level certificate holders are required to attend a refresher course specifically developed to provide updated information for the certificate program every five years to maintain recognition of the designation of WCF Safety & Health Master.
- WCF seminars attended by an applicant employed by an active policyholder of WCF within the last three years from the start of the program (January 1, 2015) will be grandfathered in and count toward certification.
- Courses must be completed by April 30th in order to be eligible to receive the award at the annual WCF Safety Awards luncheon in June of that year.
